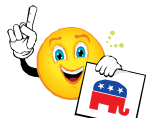

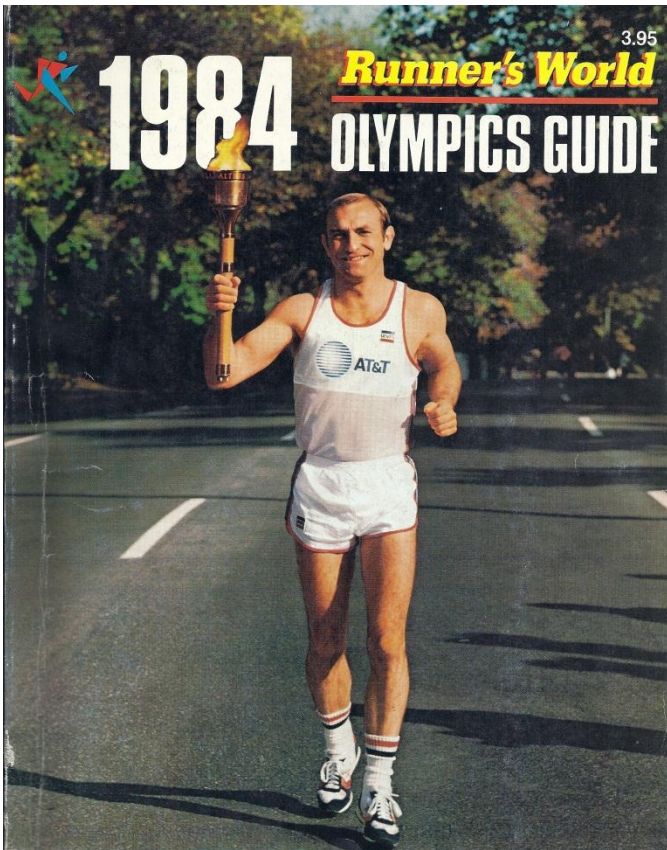
For our adult Fiction readers:

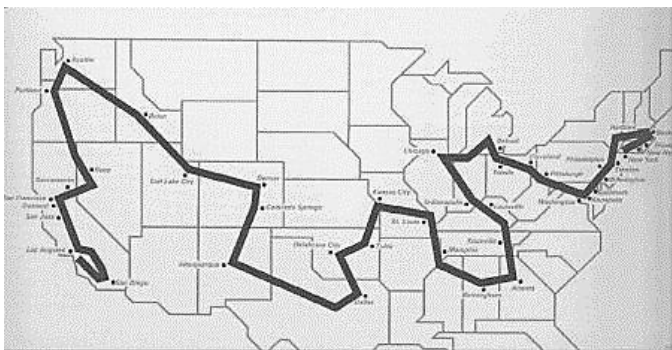
They took off for their destination of Los Angeles, California as the games were to start in July 1984.
